



Flowerpot Bread



Ingredients wholemeal flour

dried yeast

olive oil

salt









Instructions:

- Step 1: Put the flour, dried yeast, salt and olive oil in a mixing bowl. Use your hands to stretch and knead the dough for about 10 minutes.
- Step 2: Brush the flowerpots with olive oil. Shape the dough into smooth balls. Place one ball of dough into each flowerpot.
- Step 3: Place the pots on a baking tray in the oven and cook for 20-25 minutes. Use a pair of mittens when removing the pots from the oven, as they will be very hot.


